The year began with a terrific pre-season for division 1 to 3. A Division 1/2 squad was selected and the entire group worked well together for the season. For the Wohlers Cup 12 girls were selected and various combinations tried. A great deal of potential was seen. Unfortunately that early potential was not to be realised. The team was beset with injuries from the outset. Two potential members of Division 1/2 did not make it past the pre-season, then within the first month Toni Martin and Alicia Renshaw both succumbed to major ankle injuries. For Alicia, our Co-Captain, this was to be the end of her season. Toni Martin showed incredible tenacity to return to Div 2 near the end of the season and was even able to have some court time back in Division 1.

Although we lost the first 3 games we were able to see a great deal of potential and had an expectation that the later rounds would see us win a number of games. Alicia was developing well as a goalie and the defenders were combining strongly to provide many opportunities in attack. The loss of Toni and Alicia meant a major reshuffle of the team.

A replacement goalie was our first requirement and so Jacqui Renshaw was elevated to the ones to fill the gap left by Alicia's untimely injury. Jacqui worked hard and showed a great deal of potential in goals working with Megan Hoklas, who played most of the year at Goal Attack. The two girls started to develop a good understanding and Jacqui's strong leading provided a focal point in attack. Unfortunately some negative media attention saw Jacqui make the decision to leave the team. Toni's injury provided Rosie Robinson with an opportunity to again play at the Div 1 level. As Rosie is essentially a defensive player some centre court restructuring was necessary. We no longer had as much flexibility in this area of the court. Gabrielle Marschall played most games at Wing Attack, Jessica Smith at Centre and Michelle Berrigan became our versatile player who could fill in the gaps and move into any position as was required.

So it was back to the drawing board yet again. After using Nicola Biagi (from inters) and Rachel Agars (back from Queensland on holidays) it became essential to find a permanent goalie. Brooke Etscheid was to be this person. Brooke had returned to netball in 2008 after having time off to become a mother. She had settled in well to her role in Div 2, but was prepared to make the move up to Div 1. It was terrific to at last have a settled line-up (or so we thought at the time1)! Brooke and Megan began to work well together, unfortunately by now it was over half way through the season.

So how did it finish? Well; we didn't win a game although we came close against Nuriootpa in Round 9 and Gawler Central (minor premiers) in Round 10. We often won ½ or ¾ but had a problem finishing off. The team definitely showed a great deal of potential- it was not all doom and gloom.

The facts:

- We were not able to field the same team for any two weeks of the season
- We had three weeks without a second goalie
- Apart from injuries we succumbed to illness and had several game where we did not have 7 fit players
- We had the youngest side of the competition with a seventeen year old and three eighteen year olds
- Of the 2007 team less than ½ remained for 2008

On the positive side:

- We have the basis for a great team into the future
- We had two players poll in the top 7 of the Association
- The girls were all local players

Thanks to those players who filled in when we were short or sat on the bench: Nicola Biagi, Lauren Martin, Celeste Hueppauuff, Chloe Frentsch, Dom Baumgartner, and Rachel Agars.

A special thanks must go to all of those people who supported the Division 1 team during the 2008 season. Especially, Lyn Hoklas who was both team manager and primary carer and Cathy Marschall who along with Lyn coached the Div 2s and provided regular assistance, support and advice.

Also thank you to those people who regularly scored and timed. Christine Robinson was outstanding in this area, scoring or doing another duty every week. Thank you to all of the other parents, partners and Div 2s who helped out each week. And again to the Div 2s for training with us each week and always be there to back us up.
